

REFINISHING

Preparing for Service

- Repair dripping faucets and shower heads.
- ▶ Replace loose or missing tiles.
- Remove splash guards or sliding shower doors.
- If new fixtures will be installed, be sure to remove the old fixtures prior to service.
- Remove all personal belongings from the area.
- For occupied units, notify residents at least 72 hours prior to service.
- ▶ Ensure the unit's temperature is between 50 and 80 degrees.
- Do not schedule any other vendors or contractors to be in the unit the day of service.

Maintenance and Care

Proper care of the refinished surface is vital to ensure it will continue to look good for years to come. Here are some tips:

Do's

- Take extra care of the surface during the first 10 days (while the coating is going through its curing period).
- Clean the surface with Ph Neutral cleaners or cleaners approved for fiberglass surfaces.
- Periodically remove soap scum to avoid heavy build-up.
- Soft sponge when removing stubborn stains.
- ⊗ Rinse well after each use.
- Fix dripping faucets ASAP.

Don'ts

- 🔇 Don't utilize bathmats or adhesive anti-slip strips.
- On't use harsh or abrasive cleaners, specially cleaners that contain bleach or acid.
- On't leave wet shampoo/conditioner bottles on the surface.
- On't use sharp or heavy objects on the refinished surfaces.
- Solution For refinished countertops, don't allow hot pots or pans to come in direct contact with the surface.
